

## ALL 4 OPEN DAY

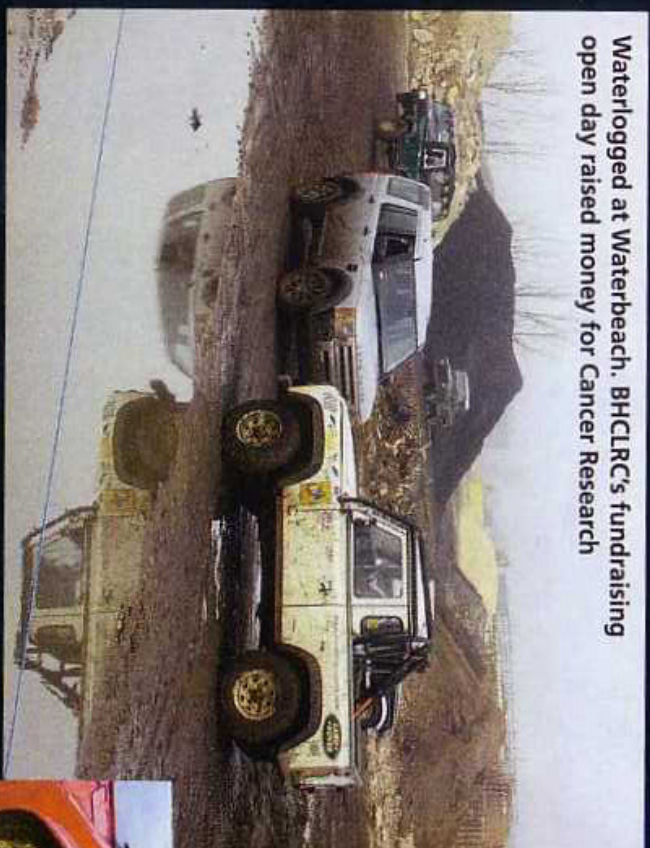
The Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire and Cambridgeshire Land Rover Club (BHCLRC) held an open day with the support of off-road accessories supplier All 4

Wheels. The club raised £838 in aid of Cancer Research, at a site in Waterbeach, Cambridgeshire, provided by local waste management specialist M Dickerson Ltd.

Green lanes officer Andy Young and Kevin Cook from All 4 Wheels proposed to run an open day aimed at teaching four-wheel-drive owners to drive responsibly, following complaints from land owners regarding the reckless use of 4x4s in the area. The idea developed into an opportunity to give customers of All 4 Wheels, and potential new members of the BHCLRC, a chance to enjoy club-style activities while raising money for charity at the same time.

The charity event included trial sections ranging from tyro to a tough RTV, green-laning and an introduction to the scrutineering process, where a few vehicles were
